



## WEEK 4: COMBINATIONAL PLAY

When a group of players pass the ball and move in coordination with each other it's called COMBINATIONAL PLAY. The purpose of combinational plays is to advance forward, past the opponents' defense.

Combinational plays include: wall pass (also called "give and go", or "one-two"), over lapping runs, and third man running.

### ***Wall pass:***

When player X is with the ball and is pressured by an opponent, attacker's teammate - X1 can run to him, receive the ball from X and pass it, deflecting the ball like a wall, behind the defender, back to running forward X.

### ***Over lapping run:***

When a player is running around the teammate with a ball, and ahead of a ball.

### ***Third man running:***

When two players are passing the ball to each other and a third attacker makes a run from behind the ball to on front of the ball.
